Here is the interior of the beautiful classroom you are building.



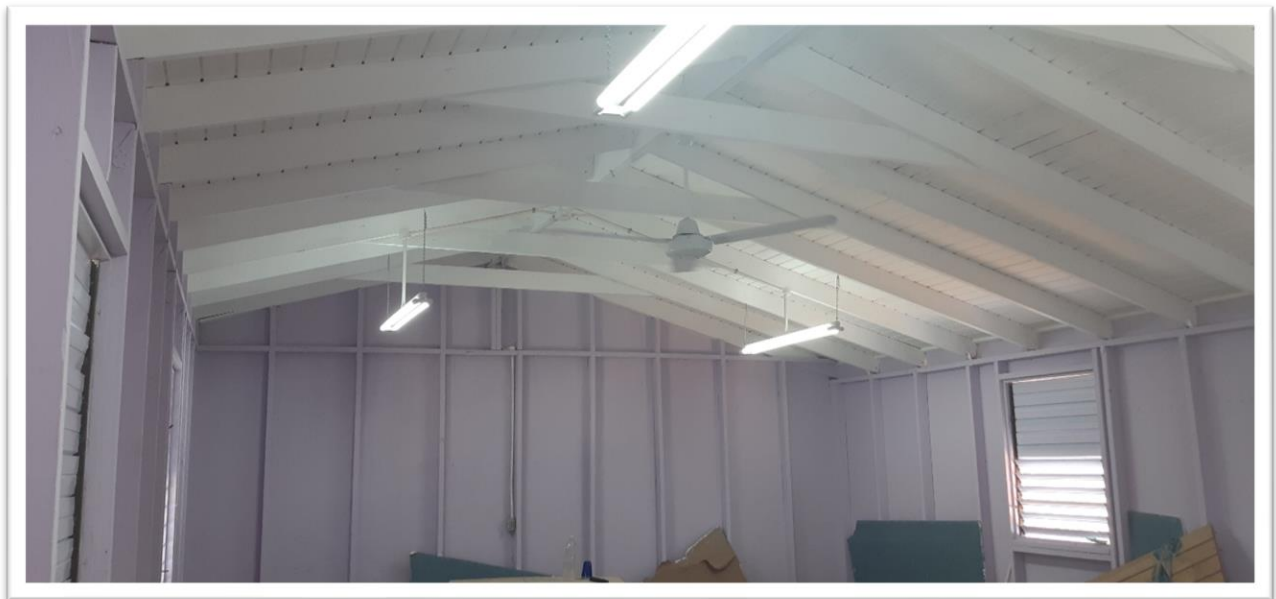
Thanks to your generosity, this school will house bright minds for generations to come.



Electrical components have been installed in the new school building.



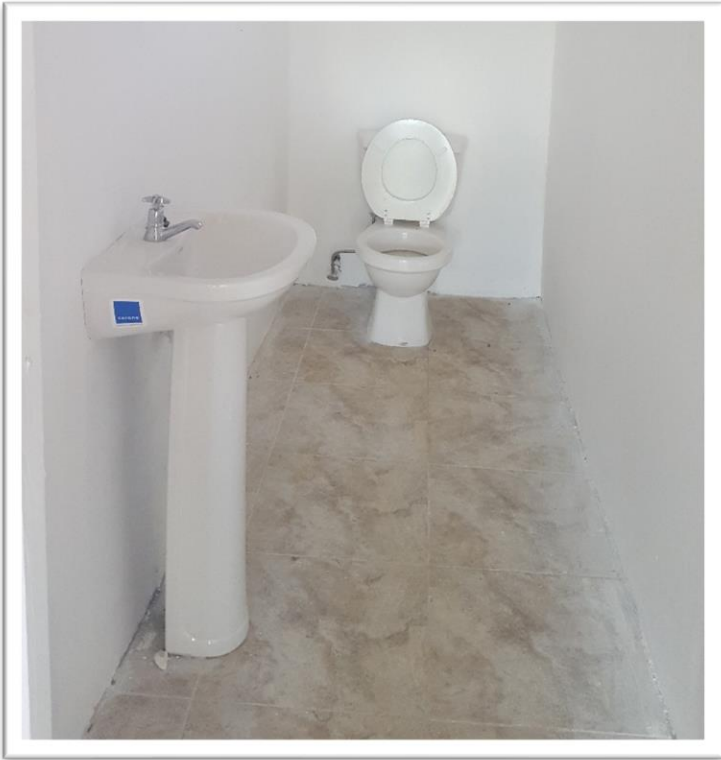
Smoke alarms and fans were placed in the building and will make sure that students will be well ventilated and secure.
